- Fits and assembles components according to assembly schematics, manuals, and knowledge of machine construction to construct, rebuild, and repair machines using hand tools and power tools
- Analyzes assembly schematics and specifications manual and plan machine building operations
- Verifies conformance of parts to stock list and drawings
- Lays out hole locations, drills and taps holes on parts for assembly
- Aligns components for assembly, manually or with hoist, bolts, screws, dowels, welds, or rivets parts using hand tools, rivet gun, and welding equipment
- Verifies alignment and tolerance of moving parts using measuring instruments such as dial indicators and thickness gauges
- Assists less skilled assemblers
- Tests operation of assembly by hand
- Assembles, sets-up, and operates machine to verify functioning, machine capabilities, and conformance to customer's specification
- May form and fasten piping, fixtures, and attachments required to service machine with air, water, and oil
- May install wiring and electrical components to specifications
